Celebrate one of the world's most famous landmarks, the Golden Gate Bridge, walking or driving across its famous span from the southern edge edge to Marin County. Start with a picture stop next to Fort Point, located under first part of the bridge. Fort Point defended San Francisco from the late gold rush era through World War II.

Chose to walk the 1.7 mile bridge or drive across it. Either way your next destination is the lone sailor statue at Vista Point, looking out from Marin County to San Francisco. Millions of servicemen shipped out from San Francisco, particularly during World II, and sailed to the battlefields of the Pacific.

Next, enjoy free time in lovely Sausalito for an independent lunch, some shopping, and taking in the beautiful views across the bay to San Francisco.

"Sausalito" means little willow in Spanish and was named for the native willow groves the Spanish found when settling the area.
