

Spring Training in Arizona



5 Days, Sunday-Thursday, March 9-13, 2025

Spring Training is a tradition in Arizona. Be at the center of it all with accommodations centrally located to all the region's ballparks with a single hotel stay at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Phoenix. In between games take in the local sounds and sites, including the Desert Botanical Garden, a cruise on Saguaro Lake onboard the Desert Belle, the Musical Instrument Museum in Scottsdale, and the Hall of Flame Museum in Tempe.

Day 1. Sun., March 9th Oakland Athletics vs. Los Angeles Dodgers

Fly to Phoenix and travel to your first game of the 2025 Cactus League Spring Training season, as the Oakland Athletics face off against the Los Angeles Dodgers at Camelback Ranch in Phoenix.

Day 2. Mon., March 10th San Francisco Giants vs. Colorado Rockies **(B)**

Visit the Musical Instrument Museum, rated as the number one attraction in the greater Phoenix area, explore a world of music and see over 4,200 instruments on display from every corner of the globe. Your second baseball game is the San Francisco Giants vs. the Colorado Rockies at Salt River Fields at Talking Stick. The ballpark is the first professional sports stadium built on Tribal land, with unmatched scenic views and interior aesthetics just as fantastic.

Day 3. Tues., March 11th Oakland Athletics vs. Arizona Diamondbacks **(B, L)**

Enjoy a leisurely morning or an optional visit to the Museum (formerly Pueblo Grande Museum). This Pre-Columbian site inhabited by Hohokam people includes an interpretive center with trails passing the recreated village and irrigation canals. Next, travel a short distance to Saguaro Lake for a cruise aboard the Desert Belle. Tonight, the Arizona Diamondbacks take on the Athletics at Hohokam Park in nearby Mesa. The Stadium is a favorite that harkens back to the intimate ballparks of Spring Training.

Day 4. Wed., March 12th Oakland Athletics vs. San Francisco Giants **(B,D)**

Discover the Hall of Flame, dedicated to the preservation of firefighting equipment used through the years around the world. Travel to Scottsdale Stadium for a game at San Francisco Giants' home field in the Cactus League as the team faces the Oakland Athletics in a Spring Training version of the "Bay Bridge Series." Following the game, travel south to one of the most unique restaurants in the Valley of the Sun, Arizona's cowboy Rustler's Rooste Steakhouse.
